I. Objective

HBH expects to purchase one (1) 2013 7/8 Passenger Minivan (#99) and trade-in an existing vehicle from the successful responsible and responsive dealer as a result of this solicitation. Also, we are interested in hybrid vehicles. If applicable, HBH will choose either all of the same model or a combination of models to best meet our needs. Awards may be granted to more than one dealer based upon the following criteria/weights:

- 1. Best price
- 2. Preferred specifications/features
- 3. Warranty
- 4. Number of certified mechanics
- 5. Customer support
- 6. Locations of service
- 7. Free Maintenance Programs offered (i.e.: oil changes, roadside assistance program, tire rotations, car washes, etc.)
- 8. Value added services
- 9. Delivery of vehicle by noon on Wednesday, August 28, 2013 for #99 only
- 10. References
- 11. Years of service

B. Pre-Proposal Conference

III. Background

Horizon Behavioral Health has facilities in the surrounding area to provide Services for Mental Health, Intellectual Disabilities, Substance Abuse and Prevention. Vehicles are used to provide transportation for HBH clients and/or for staff use for in-home service visits or business trips.

IV. Statement of Need/Specifications

HBH reserves the right to inspect the vehicles prior to award and if vehicle(s) are insufficient the RFQ will be terminated.

V. Reference Documents

Vehicle to be furnished shall conform to all applicable Federal and Motor Vehicle Safety Standards and all equipment shall conform to Title 46.2, Chapter 10, of the Code of Virginia and shall include a valid State Inspection Sticker.

VI. Quote Preparation and Submission Requirements

A. General Instructions

- 1. Quotes should be not be extensive but should convey enough information for the agency to evaluate the ability of your firm to provide the requested services.
- 2. Any exceptions to the specifications contained in this quote shall be clearly identified as an exception. Horizon Behavioral Health, in its sole discretion, will determine if the exception is acceptable as being an immaterial change to the requirements.

- 4. The original Request for Quote must be emailed also with your quote.

B. Specific Instructions

- 1. All quotes shall be returned via email to jay.goding@horizonbh.org with the subject line marked *RFQ #3340 (Minivan Purchase).* Quotes shall be signed by an authorized representative of the offeror. No faxes.
- Horizon Behavioral Health is a tax-exempt agency, as a political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Virginia. Therefore, no personal property taxes shall be charged.
- 3. Horizon Behavioral Health places public use plates on the vehicles. To that end, the following documents are required after purchase signing: DMV Application, Vehicle Title, Power of Attorney (when titled/registered in leasing company's name), and Odometer Statement
- 4. Vendors that will be performing services at a HBH site must be able to present Certificates of Insurance stating a minimum of 1 million dollar General Liability and Workers Compensation in the statutory amount. Such certificates will only be required of the successful firm.

VII. General Terms and Conditions

- A. Offerors who submit a quote in response to this RFQ may be required to give an oral presentation of their quote to the agency. This will provide an opportunity for the offeror to clarify or elaborate on the quote. The agency will schedule the time and location of these presentations. Oral presentations are an option of the agency and may not be conducted. Therefore, quotes should be complete.
- B. No member of the governing body, officer, or employee of Horizon Behavioral Health during his/her tenure or for one (1) year thereafter shall have any interest, direct or indirect, in this contract or the proceeds thereof.
- C. The agency reserves the right to accept any quote or to reject any or all quotes.
- D. Horizon Behavioral Health may make such reasonable investigations as deemed proper and necessary to determine the ability of the offeror to perform the work, and the offeror shall furnish to the agency all such information and data for this purpose as may be requested. The agency reserves the right to inspect offeror's physical plant prior to award to satisfy questions regarding the offeror's capabilities. The agency further reserves the right to reject any offer if the evidence submitted by, or investigations of, such offeror fails to satisfy the agency that such offeror is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the contract and to complete the work contemplated therein.
- E. All quotes submitted under the RFQ will become the property of the Horizon Behavioral Health and will not be returned. In accordance with the Virginia Public Procurement Act: "Trade secrets or proprietary information submitted by an offeror contractor in connection with a procurement transaction shall not be subject to public disclosure under the Virginia Freedom of Information Act; however, the offeror or contractor must invoke the protections of this section prior to or upon submission of the data or other materials, and <u>must identify the data or other materials</u> to be protected and <u>state the reasons</u> why protection is necessary."
- F. The Horizon Behavioral Health will not be responsible for any expenses incurred by a potential offeror in preparing and submitting a quote.
- G. Quotes received after the date and time stated will not be considered. It is the responsibility of the offeror to see that his quote is received via email based upon the specified time and date in MS Outlook. This date and time postmark will be the time we will be utilizing. Telephone, telegraph and facsimile quotes are not acceptable.
- H. It is understood and agreed between the parties herein that the agency shall be bound hereunder only to the extent of the funds available or which may hereafter become available for the purpose of this agreement.
- I. By submitting a Quote, the Offeror covenants and agrees that he has satisfied himself, from his own investigation of the conditions to be met, that he fully understands his obligation and that he will not make any claim for, or have right to cancellation or relief from the contract because of any misunderstanding or lack of information.
- J. Payment shall be made upon 30 days receipt of accurate and complete monthly statements.
- K. By signature on this solicitation, offeror certifies that it does not and will not during the performance of the Contract employ illegal alien workers or otherwise violate the provisions of the Federal Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986.
- L. By written notice to the Contractor, Community Services may from time to time make changes, within the general scope of the Contract, in the services provided by the Contractor. The Contractor shall promptly comply with the notice and shall perform services in conformity to the notice. If any such change causes an increase or decrease in the Contractor's cost of performance, an equitable adjustment in the payment rate shall be negotiated and the contract modified accordingly by written supplemental agreement.
- M. The Contractor shall adhere to the rules and regulations proclaimed by the Purchasing Agency regarding the confidentiality of client related information during and after the term of the contract.
- O. Failure to submit a Quote on the form provided for that purpose shall be a cause for rejection of the Quote. Return of the complete document is required. Modification of or additions to any portion of the solicitation may be cause for rejection of the Quote; however, HBH reserves the right to decide, on a case-by-case basis, in its sole discretion, whether or not to reject such a Quote as nonresponsive.
- P. HBH reserves the right to conduct any inspection it may assume advisable to assure supplies and services conform to the specifications.
- Q. Any payment terms requiring payment in less than thirty (30) days will be regarded as requiring payment thirty (30) days after invoice or delivery, whichever occurs last. However, this shall not affect offers of discounts for payment in less than thirty (30) days.
- R. In case of failure to deliver services in accordance with the contract terms and conditions, HBH, after due oral or written notice, may procure them from other sources and hold the Contractor responsible for any resulting additional purchase and administrative costs.
- S. A contract shall not be assignable by the Contractor in whole or in part without the written consent of the Executive Director of HBH.
- T. By submitting their proposals, all Offerors certify that their proposals are made without collusion or fraud and that they have not offered or received any kickbacks or inducements from any other offeror, supplier, manufacturer or subcontractor in connection with their Quote, and that they have not conferred on any public employee having official responsibility for this procurement transaction any payment, loan, subscription, advance, deposit of money, services or anything of more than nominal value, present or promised, unless consideration of substantially equal or greater value was exchanged.

- U. The agency reserves the right to cancel any subsequent contract at any time the agency, in its sole discretion, deems it to be in the agency's best interest to do so by giving the contractor 30 days written notice. Any contract cancellation notice shall not relieve the Contractor of the obligation to deliver or perform on all outstanding orders issued prior to the effective date of cancellation.
- V. By submitting their quote, all offerers certify to the Horizon Behavioral Health that they will conform to the provisions of the Federal Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, as well as the Virginia Fair Employment Contracting Act of 1975, as amended, where applicable, the Virginians with Disabilities Act, The Americans with Disabilities Act, Section 11-51 of the Virginia Public Procurement Act, and the Lynchburg Procurement Ordinance.
 - 1. During the performance of this contract, the contractor agrees as follows:
 - b. The contractor will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, religion, color, sex or national origin, age, disability, or other basis prohibited by state law relating to discrimination in employment, where there is a bona fide occupational qualification reasonably necessary to the normal operation of the contractor. The contractor agrees to post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, notices setting forth the provisions of this nondiscrimination clause.
 - c. The contractor, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of the contractor, will state that such contractor is an equal opportunity employer.
 - d. Notices, advertisements and solicitations placed in accordance with Federal Law, rule or regulation shall be deemed sufficient for the purpose of meeting the requirements of this section.
 - 2. The contractor will include the provisions of the foregoing paragraphs a, b and c in every subcontract or purchase order of over \$10,000, so that the provisions will be binding upon each subcontractor or vendor.
- W. By submitting their quote, all offerors certify to the Horizon Behavioral Health that: During the performance of the contract, the contractor agrees to (i) provide a drug-free workplace for the contractor's employees; (ii) post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, a statement notifying employees that the unlawful manufacture, sale, distribution, dispensation, possession, or use of a controlled substance or marijuana is prohibited in the contractor's workplace and specifying the actions that will be taken against employees for violations of such prohibition; (iii) state in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of the contractor that the contractor maintains a drug-free workplace; and (iv) include the provisions of the foregoing clauses in every subcontract or purchase order of over \$10,000, so that the provisions will be binding upon each subcontractor or vendor.
- X. HBH reserves the right to award a contract to a offeror based on "best value" (as defined in the Virginia Public Procurement Act, July 2009), which means the overall combination of quality, price, and various elements of required services that in total are optimal relative to the needs of HBH.
